

ADDITIONAL FUNDS AVAILABLE RELATED TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

In 2022 ALTCEW will receive several different types of federal and state funding related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The COVID-19 funds by region discussed below are available for all or part of 2022 as shown. Allocations by region are based on the 2022 Proposed Funding Allocations. Any ALTCEW subcontractor within each region can identify their 2022 needs and prepare a budget with related metrics (Number of persons to be served and Number of units to be provided) as a separate submission with their RFP and/or Contract Extension documents on or before August 31, 2021. Amounts requested within each region can be less than or equal to the amounts shown by region below. Consolidated Appropriations Act - Term 1/1/2022 to 9/30/2022; Use must be for Senior Nutrition Services. No match is required.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) - 1/1/2022 to 12/31/2022; Uses can include Senior Nutrition Services, Senior Legal, Senior Transportation, Community Living Connections, Minor Home Repair, Bath Assistance, Adult Day Services, Family Caregiver Support Program, Long Term Care Ombudsman, and Disease Prevention Health Promotion. Required match is 15% for all services except Family Caregiver Support Program which is 25%. For each grant amount awarded, state funds equivalent to the required match amount will also be awarded.

For example, if an agency is awarded \$100,000 in ARPA funds for Senior Nutrition Services. The required 15% match of \$17,647 (calculated as $\$100,000 \times 15/85$) will also be awarded in the form of state funds. So the agency will receive a total of \$117,647. A budget and related metrics should be provided for the total award of \$117,647.
