 **Spokane Transit Authority (FIXED ROUTE):**

 **Rides for Seniors: (509) 328-1552.**

People age 60 and over can use STA Paratransit vans to travel to their destinations. Customers will be required to show proof of age. Trip origins and destinations must be within STA's Paratransit boundary which is defined to be within three-quarters (3/4) of a mile from an existing bus route. Trips can be scheduled the day before, or the same day with two hours advance notice. If they choose, seniors may be accompanied by one companion. Trips are based on van availability and subject to adjustments. The Rides for Seniors fare is \$2. Fares can be paid in cash or any other Paratransit payment method (PT One Ride or a Paratransit Monthly Pass).


 **SMS Community Shuttle: (509) 534-7171**
(Spokane to Deer Park, Ritzville, Davenport & Deer Park Dial-A-Ride). **Can provide transportation to the arena for vaccinations scheduled 24 hours- two weeks in advance and if time constraints allow.**
