

How to Use Your SNAP Market Match & SNAP/EBT CARDS



1. **GO** to the market info booth.
2. **SWIPE** your SNAP/EBT card. 
3. **RECEIVE** A 100% Match in SNAP Market Match Currency for every \$1 in EBT you spend at the market. Up to \$40 a day.
4. **SHOP** and get more fruits, vegetables, mushrooms, herbs & plant starts.

Visit any vendor who sells fruit, vegetables, mushrooms, herbs, or vegetable starts to make your purchase. No change will be given for SNAP Market Match Currency.

WIC & SENIOR CHECKS




1. CHECKS


WIC: Checks will be available for pick up at your WIC clinic beginning July 6th.

SENIOR: Mail or drop-off application by June 6th to ALTCEW or Catholic Charities main office. If selected in random drawing checks will be mailed by July 1st. For more info: 509.459.6163.

2. THE SIGN

Use checks only with farmers who have this sign. 

3. PRODUCE

Buy only fresh fruits, veggies or herbs with your checks. Honey is available for seniors, only. 

4. JUNE 1 - OCT 31

Use between these dates in 2022. 

Please report lost or stolen checks to the agency that gave them to you. Unfortunately they will not be replaced. No change will be given.
