- Obtain a medical assessment to find out what may be causing the problems. (See your health care professional, a Geriatrician, a Neurologist, and/or a Neuropsychologist.)
- Complete health care planning documents such as a Health Care
   Directive. (Contact Community Living Connections at 509-960-7281 if
   needing support. A Health Care Directive can be found at
   www.dshs.wa.gov/sites/default/files/DDA/dda/documents/policy/
   policy9.01attachA.pdf.)
- Complete a General Durable Power of Attorney document. In this
  document, your loved one appoints an "agent" to assist with financial
  and related matters. (See Legal Assistance section of attached
  resources document if looking for local support.)
- Complete an estate plan. Your loved one's estate plan may include legal documents such as a will or a trust that direct the disposition of their estate upon death. (See Legal Assistance section of attached.)

- Discuss with loved one the issue of when to discontinue driving. (See the Driving section of attached resources document for local support.)
- To help your loved one:
  - Support them in managing any heart conditions, high blood pressure or diabetes as needed. This may include helping them to manage medications. (See your physician or additional medical support categories in the attached resources document.)
  - Encourage a healthy lifestyle including regular exercise, a healthy diet, and social activities. (See Exercise, Peer Support, Depression/ Mood, and Falls section in the attached resources document.)
  - Encourage the use of long-time skills, like playing the piano, singing, typing, crafts, or speaking a second language. (See Peer Support in the attached resources document.)
